Strengthening Dialogue and Cross-Training in C4ISR Disciplines with ITTA Members

CHICAGO -- Getting the training right is essential to achieve fit-for-purpose solutions to tackle terrorism and major crime. This September, over 800 international members received training and education supported by the newest methods and best practices at ITTA's 2013 C4ISR Korea conference. There was better and improved dialogue and mutual understanding between international and regional members aiding the achievement of homeland security goals. This event integrated practical training opportunities in numerous areas of tracked instruction.

Wrapping up the event, Aaron Cunningham, ITTA's President asserted success where shared experience and collaborative effort integrated with excellence in training. While KNPA Commissioner General Lee Sung-Han congratulated members "on your effective measures to maintain law and order for the security of your citizens...and preparation for unexpected terror internationally."

On the first day of the conference, Professor Jimmy Gurule Steve delivered a powerful and timely presentation stressing questions and challenges raised by our surveillance effort against terrorism and the US Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act.
